## **Kador to promote water efficiency at QME**

**Kador Engineering** will highlight the benefits of a water control system for use on mine water spray rigs on **Stand 2033** during the 2008 Queensland Mining and Engineering (QME) exhibition at the Mackay Showground from July 22-24.

The Brisbane-based company will be exhibiting on the Mining and Energy Services Council of Australia (MESCA) pavilion at QME.

Kador is the recently appointed distributor for NSW-based Hyden Engineering's Enviro-spray TM system, which was developed as a "plug-and-play" system to optimise water usage on mine roads.

The Enviro-spray TM push-button control system sets water flow rate, road speed and spot spray distances while constantly measuring tank water level, filter condition and motor condition.

It can be preset to have default water flow rates, road speed settings and spot spray distances so that an operator simply has to drive.

The Enviro-spray TM system also stops and starts the water flow at intersections and adjusts the flow rate according to machine speed.

Easily fitted options include foam injection, spray head controls, water cannon controls and water level monitors.

Kador, which specialises in heavy steel platework fabrication for the resource and transport industries, operates three manufacturing plants in Brisbane and employs more than 180 qualified tradespeople.

The company is offering the Enviro-spray TM system on its own water spray rigs or as retrofit on existing rigs. It expects the Enviro-spray TM system to be welcomed by both OEMs and mine owners as a step forward in the efficient use of scarce water supplies.
