Laser Central to take cutting edge technology to QME

Laser Central, one of Australia's premier laser cutting facilities, will feature parts produced using cutting edge technology on **Stand 2033** during the 2008 Queensland Mining and Engineering (QME) exhibition at the Mackay Showground from July 22-24.

Located in Richlands, Brisbane but supply across Australia, the company will be exhibiting on the Mining and Energy Services Council of Australia (MESCA) pavilion at QME.

In particular, the samples presented by Laser Central will spotlight:

- **tubular laser cutting** with a 3D (6-axis) laser cutting machine capable of producing tubular and structural parts up to 300 mm in diameter and 12 m long.
- **flatbed laser cutting** with the company having multiple machines for increased reliability, the capacity to handle plates up to 2500 x 4000 mm and accuracy of +/- 0.2 mm and even better with special programming if required
- **metal folding** using a 135 tonne press for pressing sheet metal up to 3050 mm long with laser measuring system. Altogether, the company has three presses.

Laser Central can laser cut a range of material including mild steel, stainless steel, aluminium alloys, high tensile steel, nickel alloys and exotic metals.
