## Ingal EPS to unveil new lighting solution at QME

**Ingal Eps** will display a new seesaw pole, described as the ideal lighting solution for improving safety and reducing maintenance costs, on **Stand 9182** during the 2008 Queensland Mining and Engineering (QME) exhibition at the Mackay Showground from July 22-24.

The Handrail Seesaw enables the maintenance of luminaires to be undertaken from ground or walkway level, eliminating the need for dangerous height work and, therefore, minimising the risk of falls and accidents.

Its many uses include mines, industrial walkways, stairways, bridges, fire escapes and power stations.

The Handrail Seesaw can:

- be installed virtually anywhere as it swings down for maintenance
- be rotated 360° to point a luminaire in any direction
- be operated by one person and requires no tools for lowering and raising
- hold luminaires and other equipment weighing up to 10 kg
- accommodate most mounting options, with spigots made to suit each application.

Suitable for wind region/terrain categories A2, A3 and B3, the Handrail Seesaw can be attached by welding or u-bolts.

The poles are hot-dipped galvanised as standard but can also be manufactured from stainless steel. Their adjustable height is from 2.3 m with the standard outreach length being 300 mm.

Ingal Eps, which has been actively involved in the Australian pole and column market since 1969, also manufactures customised Handrail Seesaws according to different height and outreach length requirements.
