RCR to release new disposable respirators at QME

RCR International will launch a new range of Pro-Val disposable dust respirators on **Stand 2079** during the 2008 Queensland Mining and Engineering (QME) exhibition at the Mackay Showground from July 22-24.

The new P1 and P2 valved and non-valved product range includes a P2 carbon disposable respirator.

As well as the new respirator range, RCR will be showing other Pro-Val products including:

- cut-resistant and palm-coated gloves ideally suited to mining and engineering operations
- chemical-resistant reusable and disposable gloves.

RCR will also show disposable coveralls at QME.

These include single layer breathable dust/dirt coveralls and Hazguard coveralls which are lightweight but strong. Made to meet type 5 and type 6 CE Standards, the Hazguard coveralls incorporate microporous technology which allows moisture vapour to pass outside from inside, keeping the wearer cooler and more comfortable.

Another highlight of RCR's stand will be De-Solve-It, a citrus-based degreaser and adhesive remover which has many uses in the mining industry. These include dissolving oil and tar build-up in a drilling core.

De-Solve-It is a biodegradable product that washes away with water.

According to RCR's national sales manager, Scott Beel, De-Solve-It is not class 3 flammable and much safer than traditional hydrocarbon solvents.
