- FireVu™ – one of Chubb's advanced digital Video Smoke Detection (VSD) systems which is based on an Internet Protocol (IP) platform and can be monitored and upgraded via the World Wide Web. It is currently used in facilities such as network cable tunnels, road tunnels and power stations.
- HART XL™ – an aspirating fire detection system designed to give very early indication of an incipient fire condition.
- Holmatro – CORE™ hydraulic rescue tools and equipment used in various emergency situations by emergency services and rescue teams.
